**Re: OBJECTION TO PROPOSED DEMARCATION: ETHEKWINI Municipality  
UMDLOTI incl SIBAYA to kwa Dukuza  
Parts of Sibaya - ward 35 to ward 102**

In writing this OBJECTION I hereby seek clarity and in doing so, seek to ascertain the rationale or reasoning behind the 'proposed demarcation of parts of Sibaya which was formerly Umhlanga (ward 35) into ward 102 which stretches as far as Cornubia, over 20 minutes away by car, from Sibaya. Similarly, the request of the Demarcation Board rationale, should include Sibaya main and Umdloti into kwa Dukuza.

In terms of the demarcation objectives as outlined in Section 24 of the Local Govt Municipality Demarcation Act, 1988, I'd like a concise response as to how Sibaya as a prime location directly contrasts or is in contradiction to the scope of the 'demarcation objectives' as outlined in Section 24. Likewise, I'm interested in ascertaining clear reasons from the Board on which 'factors were be taken into account - as outlined in the Act' when they determined the proposed delimitation of these particular municipal boundaries.

I understand the process to be followed in terms of part 3, Section 26 read with Section 27,29; 30 and 31 of the Demarcation Act and I trust and expect a response which is sink with the objectives and factors to be taken into consideration if and when the Board makes it's final determination.

I look forward to the public processes in terms of Section 26 of the Demarcation Act unfolding and likewise await your response to my letter as well as a reference number as confirmation of acknowledgement, including notices in the Official languages in the local newspapers.
